§ 6

1. If the text is accepted, I hereby grant to **Adam Mickiewicz University, Poznan**, ul. H. Wieniawskiego 1, 61712 Poznan, Poland, having Tax Identification Number (NIP) 777-00-06-350 and Business Identification Number (REGON) 000001293 – **Faculty of Law and Administration**, Collegium Iuridicum Novum, al. Niepodległości 53, 61-714 Poznań (hereinafter referred to as the “**Publisher**”), the Publisher of *Czasopismo Prawno-Historyczne*, a non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to use the Work without territorial limitation and for an unlimited period in the following fields of exploitation:

§ 8

1. In the event of any third party issuing a claim against the Publisher for the infringement of intellectual property rights, including copyright, the Author will take all necessary steps for the defence of such claims, and in the event that, as a result of such claims, the Publisher or third parties to whom the Publisher has granted the right to use the Work are required to cease using the Work in whole or in part, or when a ruling

is issued obliging them to make payments of any kind to third parties, the Author will indemnify all damages resulting from such third party claims, including reimbursement of costs and expenses incurred in connection with such claims.

2. The Author shall immediately notify the Publisher of any claims of infringement of intellectual property rights, including copyrights in the Work, asserted against the Author.
