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**Bogusław Zieliński** is a full profesor at the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań, director of the Institute of Slavic Philology. His main subject of interests includes Serbian, Croatian, Montenegrin and Bosnian literary studies of the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries, especially the history of ideas, cultural and national identity issues of Slavdom and, especially in the last decade, Slavic cultural studies. Prof. Zieliński is a member of the editorial boards of the national and many international scientific journals such as *Balkanski dijalozi*, *Riječ*, *Folia Philologica Macedono-Polonica*, *Studia Linguistica Polono-Meridinoslavica*, *Славянски диалози*, *Nasleđe*, *Balcanoslavica*, *Kroatologija*, *Pannoniana*, *СРБИСТИКА ДАНАС*. He is also a member of the editorial councils of the Library *Bosnistika – Književnost i kulturalne studije* (Sarajevo), the Croatian magazine (Uredničko vijeće) *Kroatologija*, and the magazine *Knjižestvo* (Belograd – online). He was a member of the international literary prize jury *Cum grano salis* for the best novel in Bosnia and Hercegovina, Croatia, Serbia, and Montenegro in 2005–2006.
