Izabela Lis-Wielgosz is a professor in the Institute of Slavic Philology at the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań. As an expert in the Old Church Slavonic Literature, she has published scientific books and articles dedicated to the medieval writing circle *Slaviae Orthodoxae*. Prof. Lis-Wielgosz is also an authoress of *Death in the Old Serbian Literature (12th-14th centuries)* (Poznań, 2003), *Saints in the Spiritual Culture and Orthodox Slavs' Ideology throughout the Middle Ages (till the 15th century)* (Kraków, 2005), *On Permanence of Meanings. The Serbian Literature of the Seventeenth Century in Service with Tradition* (Poznań, 2013). She is involved in literary translations, particularly regarding the selected Church Slavonic works and contemporary Slavic texts translated into Polish.

She is a member of international scientific societies: The Committee of Slavic Studies at Polish Academy of Sciences, The Commission of Comparative Research on Slavonic Literatures at the International Committee of Slavists, Center for Orthodox Church Studies of Nis (Serbia), The Waldemar Ceran Research Centre for the History and Culture of the Mediterranean Area and South-East Europe, the Scientific Council of the magazine “Crkvene Studije” (Nis, Serbia)
