Sanjin Kodrić is a full professor of Bosniak and Bosnian Herzegovinian literatures and literary and cultural theories. He is also a Chair of Bosniak literature programme at the Faculty of Philosophy, the Sarajevo University. Alongside with more than 30 books, he has edited as well as some hundred research and many professional articles. Prof. Kodrić has published six books on Bosniak and Bosnian-Herzegovinian literature and culture and other historico-literary and theoretical-literary issues. In addition to his various academic and professional activities in Bosnia-Herzegovina and abroad, prof. Kodrić is a President of the Bosniak Community Of Culture “Preporod” – the oldest and key cultural institution of Bosniaks, where he is also an executive editor of the fundamental national literary edition *Bosniak Literature in 100 books*, one of the founders and deputy managing board of the Bosnian Philology Society. Prof. Kodrić is also a member of the Commission for Comparative Study of Slavic Literatures of the International Committee of Slavists, as well as an editor or a member of the editorial boards and scientific committees of several scholarly journals in Bosnia-Herzegovina and abroad: “Pismo”, “Bosanskohercegovački slavistički kongres”, “Bosnistika plus”, “Philological Studies”, “Południowosłowiańskie Zeszyty Naukowe”, “Poznańskie Studia Slawistyczne”, “Slavica Lodziensa”, “University Thought,” etc.
